**8:30 Challenges in the Management of Headaches**

Twenty-eight million individuals in the United States suffer from migraine headaches. Yet only 48% of these individuals have actually been diagnosed with migraines. Recent research has shown that the vast majority of these individuals have been diagnosed incorrectly, many having been told that he/she suffers from sinus or tension headaches. The etiology of tension, migraine and cluster headaches will be discussed including symptoms, signs and current treatments will be discussed.

As of January 1, 2010, school nurses as mandated reporters and other professionals licensed by the Commonwealth are required to complete a training to recognize and report suspected child abuse and neglect. The speaker will discuss the mandated training that is now available on the web and review with attendees their legal obligations as mandated reporters and what happens after a 51A report is filed. Since most school nurses are well-versed in 51 A protocols, additional focus will be on understanding the role of the District Attorney's office in investigating the evidence of sexual abuse, serious child physical abuse and child exploitation which may result in criminal charges.
